### CALVIN WINTROUBE

Calvin Winetroube has an honoured place in the fellowship of the ACE Awards. He has worked tirelessly and has made an invaluable contribution to the ongoing success of the Awards.

Born in Hull, England, Calvin began drumming professionally shortly after he left school. It was his talent as a drummer that brought him to Australia in 1981. He was working on a cruise ship which berthed here, and he decided to make Australia his home – which was very much England's loss and our gain.

Calvin worked for many years as a drummer in clubs, first at City Tattersalls, then Willoughby RSL, before a long stint in residency at Dee Why RSL.

A keen amateur photographer, Calvin found that more and more artistes were asking him to produce photos for them, and so a new career was born.

He has produced superb covers for five of the eight ACE Awards Presentation Evening programs. As an enthusiastic member of the entertainment community, Calvin produced several magazines for variety performers the first of which appeared in 1989 titled 'That's Entertainment'. This was followed in 1995 by a magazine called "Live Entertainment" and finally a magazine for drummers and percussionists called "Skinfull".

Although Calvin never served on a 'MO' Committee until 2005 (he is now Deputy Executive Director) he has been known as the 10<sup>th</sup> member of the 'MO' Awards committee since 1982. His incredible contribution over a period of 24 years includes photographing the 'MO' Presentation Nights for 20 years - including 'Catch a Star Nights' and every other conceivable 'MO' function during that period. Calvin also designed many of the 'MO' souvenir programs, brochures and flyers and was the designer of the original 'MO' Website [www.moawards.org.au](http://www.moawards.org.au) which is now once again back in operation.
